Changer le monde at the heart of the Maestria residential project A collaborative artwork by the late artist Bernard Séguin Poirier and teenagers from the Centre jeunesse de Montréal illuminates the Maestria Condominiums development project

Montréal, November 22, 2023 — <u>Devimco Immobilier</u>, the Fonds immobilier de solidarité FTQ and Fiera Immobilier unveiled a masterpiece measuring 12 feet by 40 feet entitled *Changer le monde*, created in 2010 by 1,500 teenagers from the Centre jeunesse de Montréal and signed by the late artist Bernard Séguin Poirier. The work occupies a prominent place in the Maestria residential project, located in the heart of the Quartier des spectacles.

Guided by a vision of artistic expression and a sense of community, Maestria's partners had the privilege of integrating an exceptional work of art by artist Bernard Séguin Poirier, internationally renowned for his enamel-on-copper works, his creative flair, and his boundless generosity.

"By incorporating creative and collaborative features, the work strengthens community ties and contributes to the well-being of residents. It is the expression of a transformative experience that encourages young people's creativity and increases their confidence. Together, they have created a unique piece, a profound inspiration for the owners and tenants who live in the project and for the people who visit Maestria," says Serge Goulet, President of Groupe Devimco.

"We are proud to support real estate projects that reach beyond building structures. Condominiums®, a unique project that marks the first phase of the Quartier des lumières, located on the site of the former Maison Radio-Canada building. Devimco's newest condo and penthouses project is Wellington sur le Bassin®, at the corner of Wellington and De la Montagne streets.

Finally, Groupe Devimco is now completing the first phase (*Sir Charles Condominiums*) of a major TOD project in the City of Longueuil's downtown and Longueuil—Université-de-Sherbrooke metro station area.
